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RENDEZVOUS RESTAURANT 4 LG SCREEN TV'S

Recreational TVs

OVERVIEW

1. Purchase 4 Lg Screen TVs with lottery funds.

Guests frequenting the restaurant for recreation, sports games, special presentations, and special events currently cannot see what's on the tv unless they are close to it.

Sound is another issue we have, the guest sitting close to the tv gets blasted with sound and the people in the middle/back of the room cannot hear the sound.

We would like to add two large screen TVs for the dining room and two for the banquet room, this would make us a place to come and watch the sporting events and everyone could see a tv close to them. For special we could use them to display photos or if the group was doing a presentation, they could use the TVs also. Our customer base enjoys coming for the recreational aspect rather than coming to eat and drink but more for the company and camaraderie.

2. Put two TVs in the dining room and two TVs in the banquet room

Currently, we only have one large screen TV in the dining room so if you are seated in the middle of the room or towards the back you will have trouble seeing the screen. The proposal is to add two large screen TVs in the dining room so there is not a bad seat in the house, also, put two TVs in the banquet room so groups can project directly on the tv or we can have events which a lot of the time they will use the projector for a program so this would allow them to project on to the TVs and again everyone can see the screen.

3. Requirements

Wiring and connecting the TVs by Bluetooth so people can have a better-improved sound system ... we would try to do the installation in-house and with the assistance of Comcast to keep the cost down.

4. Cost

4 LG Screen TVs \$2,000 each and wiring, miscellaneous costs to hook it \$400

5. Affected Parties

With a resident population with sight and hearing issues, it will improve their experience and make it more of a recreational location to frequent and enjoy sporting events.

6. How it will affect the business

It will increase attendance at sporting events which would help increase sales and attendance, the restaurant could display, notices for recreational events, food specials, the camera club photos on the TVs, and list upcoming events for the restaurant and clubhouse.

7. Recreational Value

This will allow residents to get together and enjoy the games in a safe, friendly environment which is a walk away from their homes. For the Stanley cup finals, we have an average of 50 people in attendance looking at one screen with bad sound, for football games, in the past, we have had up to 100-150 people attend the games and again look at 1 tv screen ...

8. Implementation Timeframe

If approved, we would like to have everything in place for the football season this year, we have a lot of residents asking if we will be open for football games as there is some excitement happening with the Broncos.
